Institution's Rules to be followed

1. Students who do not attend 75% of attendance in each and every quarter will not be given stipends and book grants for that quarter.
2. Students who do not attend 75% of attendance in each and every quarter are not allowed to claim stipend and book grants for that quarter.
3. Students who borrowed books from the Library should return their borrowed books at the end of the Term. Students who do not return their borrowed books at the end of the Term will not be given admission into the next term until they return their borrowed books.
4. Students of Mizoram Polytechnic Lunglei, whoever come inside the campus in drunken or intoxicated state or found keeping any kind of intoxicating items, may be suspended or expelled from this Institute for two consecutive semesters (i.e., one year) w.e.f. current term.
5. Students of MPL, whoever create/cause/involve or encourage troubles, fights among themselves or any kind of physical assaults upon their fellow student(s) or any staff of this Institute shall be given appropriate penalties, which may lead to expulsion from this Institute for two consecutive semesters (i.e., one year) w.e.f. current term.
6. Ragging in any form is prohibited in this Institute. Hence, anyone violating this may be given anyone or all of the punishments listed below: -
 - a. Cleaning of Institution buildings/ class rooms/ toilets/ Institution surroundings at least for three days,

- whichever decided by DA&VC.
- b. In a serious situation, FIR may be lodged to the authority of law and order. i.e., Police department.
 - c. Up to three years expulsion from this Institute.
7. Disrespect, assault or abuse to any authority/staff of this Institute inside or outside the campus may lead to expulsion from the Institute.
 8. In case of deliberate damage, theft or loss of any properties of the Institute, properties of students or staff inside the campus; students responsible for such cases may be penalized in whatever way the DA & VC deems appropriate. In addition, they will have to bear the cost of repairing or replacing the same, in cash, whichever the committee/Authority deems fit. If the responsible students refused to comply with the penalties, further action may be taken by the DA & VC accordingly.
 9. All the students of MPL should refrain themselves from smoking inside the campus and inside the classroom. Anyone violating this rule shall be subjected to appropriate penalty whatsoever the DA&VC deems fit.
 10. MPL students are expected to have good, healthy and harmonious relations with the neighbouring villages. If any student of MPL creates or causes troubles or fights with any person from the neighbouring villages, or the village itself, which may lead to misunderstanding between this Institute and the neighbouring communities, or defame the Institute itself; such cases shall be considered as a serious misconduct, and the responsible student(s) shall be given severe punishment, which may lead to expulsion from the Institute.
 11. In case of use of unfair means in any form during examination by any student, he/she will be punished as per the MSCTE rules. Stern action shall be taken against those students who violate the examination rules.
 12. All the students of this Institute are expected to cooperate heartily with the faculty and staff in keeping the Institute campus clean. If any student is found deliberately/carelessly throwing litter of any kind, spitting etc inside the class room, corridors and verandah, appropriate actions shall be taken against them.
 13. Students should attend classes with proper, neat and tidy complete uniforms only. If any student is to attend classes without or incomplete uniform, he/she should obtain prior written permission from the Principal after routing through the concerned class master/ class mistress and HOD.

THE BLACK DOT STATUTE / DECREE:

In addition to the punishment mentioned in the disciplinary rules stated above, the Black Dot system shall be implemented in accordance with the severity of the offence committed by the student(s) against the standing rules, and shall be given to any offender as follows:

1. The Total Five Black Dots may directly be given to any student who commits the following offences:
 - 1) Comes inside the Institution campus in a drunken or intoxicated state or found keeping any kind of intoxicant (such as Liquor, Drugs, Marijuana, etc) inside the campus and Hostels.
 - 2) Creating and involves in troubles/fights among the students, or physically assaulting his/her fellow student(s) or any staff of this Institute.
 - 3) Deliberately damaging any property(s) of the Institute, property(s) of students or staff.
 - 4) Theft of any properties of the Institute, properties of students or staff.
 - 5) Involves in ragging.
 - 6) Creating or causing fights with people from neighbouring villages; which may defame the Institute, or cause misunderstanding with the neighbouring communities.
2. One black dot shall be awarded to any student who commits the following offences:
 - 1) Found smoking inside the class room.
 - 2) Disrespect or abusing authority/staff of this Institute.
 - 3) Cheating inside examination hall.
 - 4) Comes with incomplete uniform without prior permission from the authority.
 - 5) Continuous absence from classes more than a week without permission.
 - 6) Persistently coming late for classes (*if more than three times*).
3. Any unmentioned cases, which, the DA & VC considered a minor offence, shall be given a Half-Black Dot.

4. A student may be given at most **Five Black dots** in total, that accumulates from the dots he/she have been given from any of the above three points. If a student received five or more black dots, he/she shall be automatically suspended from this Institute for a specified period of time, which the DA&VC deems appropriate.

I promised to abide by all the above rules failing which I promised to accept all types of punishments to be inflicted upon me by the Institute's authorities.
